

Prescribing Oxygen on HEPMA


Oxygen should be prescribed on HEPMA (Screenshot 1) as a regular drug to be administered four times daily. HEPMA gives the option to prescribe 3 different target saturation ranges (Screenshot 2). If selecting the "Other" target, an order note must be added to "Appear When Charting" (Screenshot 3). This will alert the nursing staff to the required target saturation range.



Screen Shot 1 – Oxygen Prescription on HEPMA




Screen Shot 2 - Oxygen Prescribing Options

Guidance for administration checks of Oxygen flow on HEPMA

If required, oxygen should be administered continuously and the nurses check the patient's oxygen requirements at these 'administration times' or more frequently if appropriate, and document in HEPMA how much oxygen is being delivered. If a patient is not requiring oxygen, nurses should select the option 'Patient on Room Air' (Screenshot 4) from the non-administration drop down menu.
